

**2016 Knox County High Schools  
Virtual Summer School Application  
For students who attended grades 9, 10, 11 or 12 during 2015-2016 school year**

**Location:** All KCS high schools

**Dates:** May 25-July 1

**Daily Schedule:** 8:30-12:00 Monday through Friday. Classes will be offered for both makeup credit and new credit. Driver's Education will be offered at only two locations: Central High School and Hardin Valley High School. Students who wish to take Driver's Education will report to either one of these locations on the first day of class.

**Fee:** A non-refundable fee must be paid the first day of the student's summer session

- \$10 for all courses except Driver's Education
- \$120 for Driver's Education

\* Students receiving free or reduced price meals in a Knox County high school in 2015-2016 may apply for exemption of class fee.

**Courses:** All classes will be taken online with the exception of Driver's Education. Every student will be required to attend class from 8:30 until 12:00 for the first 10 days. IF adequate progress is shown, the student may then choose to complete coursework from home or any remote location. All students will return to school to complete the end of course test. If the student fails to show continued progress while working from home, he/she will be required to return to school to complete work.

- Students enrolled in Driver's Education will attend five days of class and complete assigned hours of driving. All students who wish to participate must be 15 years of age or older and must meet the state requirements for attendance and academic progress.

**Make-up credit:** Students may make up a full-unit grade of "C", "D", or "F" received by completing the online course work and the End-of-Course test. Courses in which students earned a grade of either "A" or "B" may not repeat a course in summer school. If a student does not complete the online course in summer school, he/she may continue the coursework with the permission of the principal. The principal will determine the date and time by which the coursework must be completed.

**Grades/Credit:** A progress report will be issued at the end of the first 10 days. A cumulative numerical percent will be reported when the coursework and End-of-Course test are completed. Grades will be calculated using the Knox County Schools' guidelines for recovery credit. Please note, State End of Course tests will not be administered in summer school.

**Transportation:** Students are responsible for their own transportation.

**Attendance: NO ABSENCES permitted!** In order to earn the privilege of working at home, students must be in full attendance the first 10 days.

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**STUDENT INFORMATION AND RULES**

All rules are strictly enforced.

1. NO ABSENCES.
2. NO EARLY DISMISSAL FROM CLASS.
3. TARDINESS. Students will be dropped from summer school on the sixth tardy. Driver’s Education students will be dropped on the third tardy.
4. All students must follow the rules of their teachers and obey any faculty member while attending summer school.
5. All assigned work must be completed to receive credit.
6. All fees must be paid on the first day of class or the student will not be permitted to enroll. Fees are non-refundable.
7. Students must abide by all school rules and Knox County Schools board policy, including but not limited to:
  - o Student dress and grooming are regulated to the extent that they do not interfere with the educational process or personal safety as determined by the administration.
  - o The administration will provide information about parking. Students are not permitted to return to their vehicle or the parking lot at any time except when departing for the day.
  - o Students in possession of a weapon will be dropped from summer school and turned over to law enforcement.
  - o Students under the influence, in possession of, or using drugs or alcohol will be dropped from summer school.
  - o Students using, or in the possession of tobacco products will be dropped from summer school.
  - o Valuables such as money, pocketbooks, etc. are the responsibility of the student.
  - o Students are not to be out of class at any time except for scheduled breaks.
  - o Conduct by any student that is prejudicial to good order or discipline, as determined by the administration, may result in that student being dropped from summer school.
